System requirements

- An internet connection – broadband wired or wireless (3G or 4G/LTE)
- Speakers and a microphone – built-in or USB plug-in or wireless Bluetooth
- A webcam or HD webcam - built-in or USB plug-in
- Or, a HD cam or HD camcorder with video capture card
- If working from a desk top computer, a single screen

ZOOM will operate on most systems, PC's; Laptops; Tablets (Android or iOS (Apple); Surface Pro (2 or 3)

IMPORTANT NOTE:

All training session is attended by the individuals, from the comfort of their own home. They do not need to be in the same room. However, they will work as a group in a virtual classroom situation, interacting with each other and the facilitator.
