MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

FELLOW

The highest corporate grade for those who have the necessary qualifications and senior managerial experience (see overleaf for exact requirements). This grade carries the right to the designatory letters FIQ



MEMBER

The standard grade of membership for those with an approved qualification and basic line management or specialist experience in the industry. Designatory letters MIQ



ASSOCIATE

This category is for those persons having experience of the industry but without formal qualifications and those working towards a qualification or gaining experience.



STUDENT

This category is for those persons having experience of the industry but without formal qualifications and those working towards a qualification or gaining experience

Progression through the grades of membership is shown above, however, direct entry into any grade is possible, provided that the applicant has the necessary qualifications and experience (see overleaf)

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- b) Be at least 33 years of age.
- c) Have met the Membership requirements (see below).
- d) Have at least seven years' experience in the industry, including four years in a position of senior management.

Member

- a) Must be employed in the industry.
- b) Be at least 23 years of age.
- c) Have passed the Professional Examination of the Institute or possess exempting qualification.
- d) Have completed a period of training and experience in the industry, of which not less than three years was in a position of responsible charge.

NOTE

Inspectors of Mines and Quarries are exempt from requirements c) and d) for Fellow and Member grades, provided that they have had seven years' experience in post (for Fellow) or three years' experience (for Member)

NON-CORPORATE GRADES

GUIDELINES

'Industry': the extraction and processing of surface materials including crushed and dimension stone, sand and gravel, clays, opencast coal, asphalt, cement, ready-mixed concrete and concrete products, plus companies supplying goods and services to the quarrying industry.

Mines and quarries inspectors, drilling and blasting contractors, lecturers in quarrying at recognised colleges, technical consultants, and minerals planning officers are regarded as being employed within the industry.

'Experience in the industry': full time employment in the industry, including industrial periods of approved courses.

'Senior managerial charge': in charge of a significant operation; an area or regional manager; a recognised senior staff appointment; head of a department, etc.

'Position of responsible charge': appointments such as quarry manager or assistant manager, a person in charge of a section of a quarry or associated plant; those in recognised technical, administrative or sales appointments.

'Exempting qualification': an approved technical or administrative qualification. Refer to local secretary.

'Technical qualification': an academic qualification approved by Council at not less than HNC Level appropriate to the person's discipline, e.g. HNC Civil Engineering, HND Mechanical Engineering, BSc Geology.

'Administrative qualification': an academic qualification approved by Council at not less than HNC Level appropriate to the person's discipline, e.g. HNC Business

Associate

- a) Must have reached the age of 21, passed the Professional Examination of the Institute OR
- b) Have reached the age of 21, have obtained an approved technical or administrative qualification and have at least one year of experience in the industry OR
- c) Have reached the age of 21 and have completed three years' experience in the industry

NOTE

Mature candidates' rights are available to Associates over the age of 38 years who have 10 years experience in the industry, including five years in a position of managerial charge. The applicant can qualify for the corporate grades of Fellow or Member through the preparation of a thesis or by passing the Quarrying Operations and Safety and Legislation papers of the Institute's Professional Examination.

Student

- a) Must be at least 16 years of age and normally not more than 21 (unless extended at the discretion of Council)
- b) Be engaged in a full-time course of study or training relating to the industry
