EFFECTIVE RISK MANAGEMENT

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Effective Risk Management course is delivered online and it explains the fundamental concepts of managing workplace risks, and the legislative and regulatory environment in which quarries operate.

The course is suitable for managers, supervisors and key support personnel and will cover:

- Establishing the end to end process for systematic management of risk, including risk identification and analysis
- Application of the hierarchy of controls to identified risks
- Implementation of control measures
- The essential role of effective consultation and communication in managing risk
- Reviewing and improving risk management processes

The course will take approximately 4 hours to complete and can be paused and re-commenced at any time.

Who should do the course?

The course is targeted at those responsible for managing risk in a quarry. This may be the Quarry Manager, Quarry Supervisor, leading hands or other roles. The course can act as a refresher for experienced staff, or be used as an introduction for newer staff.

CPD for New Zealand:

This course meets the requirements for Unrestricted Activities under the WorkSafe CPD Guidelines.

CPD hours: 4 hours - Risk Management. A completion certificate will be issued once finished

Why attend?

Quarrying is a high-risk workplace. Ensuring staff are adequately trained to identify and manage hazards and risks can make the workplace much safer.

Delivery

Delivery is fully online. This means learning can take place at any time during normal work hours or after work. As it is self-paced, the learner can take their time to ensure they fully understand the material. The course can be paused and re-commenced at any time and provides greater flexibility for the employer and the learner as learning can be scheduled around production.

As the course is online it can be undertaken at any time. It will take approximately 4 hours to complete.
