Who can apply?

The Scholarship is awarded to individuals who are studying a nationally recognised qualification to advance their career within the quarrying sector.

Scholarship recipients must be an IOQ member for a minimum of 12 months prior to applying for the scholarship.

What can I receive?

The Scholarship includes all course fees, travel, accommodation and incidental expenses up to \$3,000 per annum, up to a maximum of three years.

Who administers the Scholarship?

The Scholarship Trustees include: The President, Vice-President and Past President of The Institute of Quarrying New Zealand (Inc.) and two representatives from B. R. Webster family.

Important Information to note

- You will need someone who is willing to nominate you for the Scholarship and that person should be your mentor throughout the period of your study.
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- You will need to supply a letter of support from your employer.
- You will need to supply an outline of the course/qualification you plan to study.
- Receipts for all costs must be provided.
- It is a requirement that the Scholarship recipients each submit a report every twelve-months to the Trustees of the Scholarship reporting their progress towards the achievement of the qualification.

- Scholarship recipients must remain an IOQ member for the duration of the scholarship. Failure to do so, may result in the termination of the scholarship.
- It is expected that Scholarship recipients will remain in the quarrying industry for a minimum period of two years upon completion of their studies.
- Failure to achieve the requirements of the qualification in any one year could result in termination of the Scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced at the annual Quarry NZ Conference and upon completion, graduates will also be awarded their qualification at the Conference.
- The Trustees reserve the right to not award a Scholarship in any year. The Scholarship Trustees may elect to extend the Scholarship criteria to include other qualifications at its sole discretion. The decisions of the Scholarship Trustees are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

How do I apply?

Applications close on 30 May each year. You will need to complete the attached application form, provide a copy of your curriculum vitae and a letter of support from your employer.
